PREVENTION OF WOMEN SEXUAL HARASSMENT CELL

IBSAR School of law established Prevention of Women Sexual Harassment Cell on 25-08-2017 with the objective of redressing the grievances of the students and the staff of any matter related to women and to provide safe and healthy environment for women employee and students to work, study and explore their potential to the fullest.

Objectives of the Cell-

1. The cell aims to look into the complaints lodged by any student and redress it as per the college norms
2. The cell shall deal with the complaints of sexual harassment and any other type of harassment of the female student teaching and non-teaching women staff of the college.
3. To ensure the fair and timely resolution of sexual harassment complaints.
4. To organise various functions acquainting the women regarding their rights.
5. To take protective steps in the matter of gender discrimination and harassment within the campus.
6. To provide special counseling to the faculty and students as and when necessary.

Grievance Redressal Procedure:-

1. The complainant shall submit a written complaint addressed to the co-ordinator of the Shell.
2. The convener SHALL CALL CALL COMPLINTS AND INFORM Him to submit written Statement
3. The Members Of The Cell shall discuss the complaint and submit the report to the appropriate Authority to Take Necessary Action.
