7.<u>According to the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, it is illegal to affix</u> <u>the emblem or official name of the Maharashtra Government, Police or any</u> <u>other government department on a vehicle, unless the vehicle is for official use</u>.

Legal Process.

1. Motor Vehicles Act, 1988:

Sections 50 and 52: Any alteration (such as emblem, logo, sticker) in a vehicle which is inconsistent with the information in the original registration certificate, is illegal. 2. Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989:

Rules 50 and 51 prescribe the form and size of the number plate of vehicles. It is illegal to affix any unauthorized word, logo or symbol on the number plate.

3. Rules for using government emblems:

As per the State Emblem of India (Prohibition of Improper Use) Act, 2005, the use of government emblems is restricted to authorized government vehicles only. Such use on private vehicles is punishable.

Provision of Penalty:

If a vehicle driver illegally writes or displays the government emblem, the words Police or Maharashtra Government, the concerned authority has the right to impose a penalty. In this case, the local Motor Vehicle Department (RTO) or the police administration decides on the amount of penalty.

Conclusion:

The words Government emblems, Police or Maharashtra Government should be avoided from being displayed or displayed on private vehicles. Action may be taken in such cases. An action order has been issued by the department in this regard.
